Wat Mahathat: Buddhist temple ruins, colorful shrines and a famous Buddha head, around which the roots of a tree have grown.

Wat Phra Ram

Wat Phra Si Sanphet Remains of a majestic royal palace temple with three restored towers and views of the surrounding countryside.

Wat Chaiwatthanaram An impressive building restored from the ruins of a 17th century royal Buddhist temple in a picturesque riverside setting.

Wat Tha Ka Rong Buddhist Temple is the furthest -7.4 km, 2 hours walk from the train station
